The Cormac Trust was established following the death of Cormac McAnallen, who died suddenly from SADS (Sudden Arrhythmic Death Syndrome).

Over the last 4 years the Trust has worked hard to provide information to increase the awareness of the condition that causes sudden cardiac death in the young, as well as promoting screening which can help identify and treat such conditions.

We have provided almost 100 defibrillators to local councils and sports clubs cross-community and Province wide and are continually working hard to encourage Government and Health departments across the Island of Ireland on the need for action - Cormac died from a heart condition which can affect anyone.

The Cormac Trust Golf Classic is organised as part of our fundraising programme, to generate much needed financial support, so that we can continue our work, to generate greater awareness, promote screening and research and to help reduce the chances of young people dying from such heart conditions.

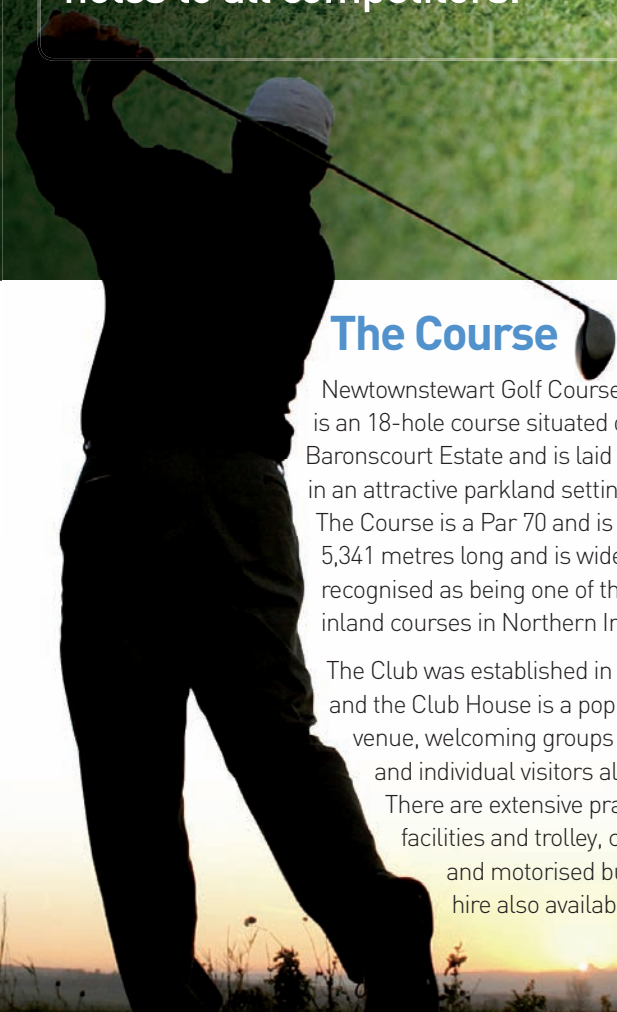

### The Course

Newtownstewart Golf Course is an 18-hole course situated on Baronscourt Estate and is laid out in an attractive parkland setting. The Course is a Par 70 and is 5,341 metres long and is widely recognised as being one of the best inland courses in Northern Ireland.

The Club was established in 1914 and the Club House is a popular venue, welcoming groups and individual visitors alike.

There are extensive practice facilities and trolley, club and motorised buggy hire also available.

### How to get there

Follow signs for M1 motorway heading west and continue to Ballygawley where you should turn right at the roundabout onto the A5 signed Omagh.

From Omagh turn left at the traffic lights onto the bypass and continue on A5 until next roundabout, taking second left exit for Newtownstewart / Strabane and Derry (A5).

Follow signs to Newtownstewart and travel along new bypass taking second exit left signed Newtownstewart.

Signposted from Strabane road (A57) at Newtownstewart. 2 miles west of Newtownstewart on B84.
